Participant Eligibility

To be eligible for Construction Skills Queensland (CSQ) Funding, you must meet the following eligibility requirements, and provide the necessary documentation in the table below to substantiate your eligibility:

1. Have the right to work in Australia.
2. Are an **Eligible Worker** or **Unemployed Eligible Worker** that shows evidence of substantial engagement in the Building and Construction industry in Queensland.

Employment Status (Choose One)	Evidence Required
Employed Eligible Worker	Please provide one of the following: a) Employer letter on letterhead, dated and signed by your Employer detailing your roles and duties within the Building and Construction industry b) Statutory Declaration providing details of employment in the Building and Construction industry. <i>Please contact our team for Template.</i>
Unemployed Eligible Worker (Unemployed for 6 months or less)	Statutory Declaration providing details of relevant past employment in the Building and Construction industry. <i>Please contact our team for Template.</i>
Self-Employed Eligible Worker	Please provide one of the following: a) Invoices for recent work in the Building and Construction industry (min. two) and copy of ABN/ACN registration showing ownership b) Statutory Declaration providing details of business registration and recent work in the Building and Construction industry. <i>Please contact our team for Template.</i>

Exceptions

For this program, an Eligible Worker can include:

- Administrative, clerical, and professional staff whose Employer is part of the Building and Construction Industry
- Employees of a Local Council who is undertaking roles which would be considered an Eligible Worker



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A Participant MUST:

1. Only commence a maximum of one (1) Higher Qualification in total across the Programs during the Contract Term.
2. NOT complete more than 50% of the Qualification through RPL and/or credit transfer.

And MUST NOT:

- Be an Apprentice or Trainee
- Be undertaking the training as part of an Apprenticeship or Traineeship
- Be an Employee of an Authority
- Be currently enrolled and participating in a Queensland secondary school program
- Be a contracted trainer or assessor or existing worker of an RTO
- Be funded by an Authority or such other source for the delivery of the same Training being undertaken as part of this Program
- Be enrolled in more than one (1) Skill Set or Qualification at a time under this Program and the Skills Assessment and Gap Training Program which is 1 x Building or 1 x Civil in the same Program period
- Have previously enrolled into the same or equivalent qualification in an earlier Program term
- Be seeking a Verification of Competency
- Be an International Student

*Schedule 1

- An **Eligible Worker** is someone who can demonstrate primary and substantial direct involvement in the Building and Construction industry doing:
 - Construction, significant renovations and extensions of, residential and commercial buildings
 - Installation services for interiors of residential and commercial building in associated trades; electrical, plumbing, flooring, etc.
 - Works on a CSQ designated Major Project – construction of infrastructure
- An **Unemployed Eligible Worker** is a person who has been unemployed for a period no greater than 6 months in Queensland, that would otherwise meet the requirements of an Eligible Worker.
