Introduction

The Provide First Aid course provides training and assessment on the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the [Australian Resuscitation Council \(ARC\) guidelines](#) as well as first aid in multiple scenarios.

The unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide first aid and CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

According to the [Safe Work Australia First Aid in the Workplace \(Code of Practice\)](#), it is a requirement for individuals to participate in First Aid refresher training every 3 years, and CPR refresher training every 12 months.

Information for Overseas Students

Blue Dog Training can deliver the First Aid and CPR course to overseas students without having CRICOS registration. More information is available at [Australian Skills Quality Authority](#).

Course Details

This course contains the following three units of competency:

1. HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
2. HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support
3. HLTAID011 Provide First Aid

This course is designed to equip learners with the skills needed to perform first aid and CPR in an emergency situation.

The combination of delivery modes for this course allows you to fit your study into your work, family and social commitments. This course is designed to be completed sequentially and is anticipated that the entire course is completed within a one-week period:

- Online theory training and assessment: estimated to take 5 hours to complete.
 - Once you have completed the Online theory training and assessment, you will be given the option to book your face-to-face practical training and assessment a time suited to you.
- Face-to-Face practical training and assessment, estimated to take 4.5 hours to complete as per class timetabling.
 - Conducted in person at a Blue Dog Training location and is dependent on timetabling.

Learners have up to three months to complete all training and assessment activities.

You have a maximum of three (3) submission attempts to successfully complete the assessment activities for this course. If you are not deemed competent after the third attempt, you will be required



to re-enrol in the program.

This course is nationally accredited and on successful completion of the course, a Statement of Attainment will be issued to you through Blue Dog Training. You can show your employer the Statement of Attainment as proof of currency.

Note: Given the nature of this course, it is not appropriate for learners to apply for RPL or credit transfer as their currency in skills must be demonstrated via course completion/does not meet [SafeWork](#) currency requirements and may affect your status as a workplace first aid officer.

Entry Requirements

You will need the following as a minimum to complete the course:

- One form of identification,
- An email account,
- A phone or other electronic device with internet access,
- Basic language, literacy, numeracy, and digital literacy (LLND) skills,
- A Unique Student Identifier (USI),
- Transportation to a designated Blue Dog Training location to complete the practical assessment,
- **Physical capacity to perform CPR on an adult manakin placed on the floor for 2 uninterrupted minutes.**

Support

You will be given access to the following education and support services:

- Dedicated trainer support, via phone and email,
- Face-to-face interaction with a trainer at a Blue Dog Training office,
- Other mechanisms, such as assistance in using technology.

You will be given access to the following learner resources:

- Online portal, containing the Learner Guide and assessment,
- Contact details for your trainer,
- All physical resources required to complete the face-to-face practical training and assessment (provided when you attend the face-to-face session), including:
 - Adult and infant resuscitation manikins that follow ARC guidelines,
 - AED training devices,
 - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE),
 - A fully equipped first aid kit that contains all materials to perform simulated assessments.

Under fee-for service arrangements you can commence your course at any time throughout the year. This amount must be paid at the time of enrolment.
