OUR TRAINERS

The difference at Blue Dog Training is the people standing in your workshop.

Our trainers are not career academics. They are qualified tradespeople and educators who have worked in the construction and engineering industries. They understand what students are walking into when they take up an apprenticeship, and they deliver training that reflects that.

Every Blue Dog trainer holds a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE). The person standing in your workshop is not just trade qualified, they are formally trained to teach.

Every school is assigned a dedicated trainer, local to your region, who serves as your single point of contact. They attend school events and information sessions, communicate directly with VET coordinators and heads of department, and stay across the program end to end.

OUR VETiS PROGRAM

Blue Dog Training delivers nationally recognised VETiS qualifications across construction and engineering to students in Years 11 and 12.

Theory is delivered through our interactive online Learning Management System (LMS), giving students 24/7 access to learning materials and allowing schools and parents to track progress in real time. Practical assessment is completed on site in your school workshop with full supervision and guidance from your BDT trainer.

The program runs on a fortnightly delivery schedule across each term, sits within the student timetable as a subject line, and carries no cost to the school. We also contribute \$400 per funded VETiS student toward workshop materials and equipment.

Students can enrol in one or both qualifications, for a potential total of 8 QCE core credits.

Eligible students are fee free. The second qualification a student enrolls into comes at a fee for service cost of \$0.

The Queensland Government covers the cost of one funded VETiS place per student through the Department of Trade, Employment and Training (DTET).

MEM20422 CERTIFICATE II IN ENGINEERING PATHWAYS

2 years (Year 11 to 12). Up to 4 core QCE credits.

The qualification provides students with an introduction to an engineering or related working environment. Students gain skills and knowledge in a range of engineering and manufacturing tasks which will enhance their entry-level employment prospects for apprenticeships, traineeships or general employment in an engineering-related workplace.

Completion of this qualification is a useful step towards the following career pathways:

- ✓ Engineering - Fabrication Trade (Boilermaking/Welding)
- ✓ Engineering - Fabrication Trade (Sheetmetal working)
- ✓ Engineering - Mechanical Trade (Fitting and/or Turning)
- ✓ Engineering - Mechanical Trade (Machining)
- ✓ Engineering - Mechanical Trade (Diesel Fitting/Fixed & Mobile Plant Mechanic)





CPC20220 CERTIFICATE II IN CONSTRUCTION PATHWAYS

2 years (Year 11 to 12). Up to 4 core QCE credits*.

The CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction Pathways provides students with a strong foundation for entry into a range of primary trade pathways within the construction industry, excluding plumbing. The qualification is designed to introduce learners to recognised construction trades while developing essential skills and knowledge that support progression into an Australian Apprenticeship.

This qualification includes core units of competency that are common to many Certificate III construction trade qualifications, enabling students to gain meaningful credit toward further training.

Elective units are structured to provide exposure to a variety of trade skill areas, allowing students to explore potential career options and make informed decisions about future pathways.

There are no entry requirements for this qualification, making it accessible to students seeking an introduction to the construction industry.

Completion of this qualification supports progression into the following construction trade pathways:

- ✓ Carpentry
- ✓ Brick and blocklaying
- ✓ Wall and floor tiling
- ✓ Plastering
- ✓ Painting and decorating

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS FOR YOUR SCHOOL

Getting started is simple. We work around you.

Blue Dog Training manages the entire enrolment process in partnership with the school, including funding eligibility checks, USI collection, parent or carer acknowledgement of training entitlements, and LMS setup. Your school does not carry the paperwork.



Delivery runs on a standard subject line with our trainer being at your school a minimum of once a fortnight. Students' other subject lines are not affected.

Schools have ongoing access to the LMS to monitor student progress, completion data, and assessment outcomes at any time.

If you are thinking about adding a VETiS stream, upgrading a current arrangement, or reviewing your existing RTO partnership, we would be glad to talk through what that looks like for your school.

We hold Skills Assure Supplier (SAS) status to deliver funded VETiS delivery across Queensland LGAs.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUR STUDENTS

CPC20220 Certificate II in Construction Pathways opens pathways into apprenticeships across carpentry, bricklaying, painting, plastering, tiling, concreting, and more.

MEM20422 Certificate II in Engineering Pathways opens doors in fabrication, welding, boilermaking, sheetmetal working, fitting, machining, and diesel fitting.

All Blue Dog Training partner schools receive 25% off our full workshop program.

Our ITD upskilling workshops are practical, full day sessions designed specifically for Queensland school teachers and teacher aides. They are delivered by experienced trades professionals and run out of a real school workshop environment with real tools and machinery.



ITD WOODWORK AND CONSTRUCTION FOR EDUCATORS

Workshops covering woodwork fundamentals, machinery skills, construction foundations, setting out, and framing and finishing.



ITD METALWORK AND ENGINEERING FOR EDUCATORS

Hands on training in sheet metal, machining and turning, MIG welding, TIG welding, and combined MIG and Stick welding.



ITD SUPPORT AND TECHNOLOGY FOR EDUCATORS

Practical sessions covering workshop maintenance, supporting workshop classes, digital fabrication and 3D technologies, and CAD foundations using Autodesk Inventor.

Each workshop runs for one full day and participants receive a certificate of completion, a take home project, lunch, coffee throughout the day, and a Blue Dog gift pack. FIRST AID, CPR AND WHITE CARDS FOR SCHOOLS

Keep your staff and students prepared with nationally recognised training from Blue Dog Training.



FIRST AID AND CPR

We deliver accredited courses that meet current Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines, covering CPR, management of injuries and illness, and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED). Schools can arrange group bookings for staff or students and our trainers come to you.

- ✓ **HLTAID011 Provide First Aid** (includes HLTAID010 and HLTAID009). Three-yearly renewal required, with annual CPR renewal.
- ✓ **HLTAID009 Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation.** Annual renewal required.

Participants complete theory online in their own time, then attend a face-to-face practical assessment. On successful completion, a Statement of Attainment is issued.



WHITE CARDS

The White Card - CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry - is mandatory before anyone can access a building or construction site in Australia.

For VETiS students enrolled in CPC20220, White Card training is included at no additional cost.

Schools can also arrange standalone White Card sessions delivered on site. The standard delivery timeframe is a minimum of 4.5 hours. All high school students are eligible for a discounted rate.

Minimum group size applies.
